

DHS Student Guidelines For Chromebooks



Devine ISD is working towards each student having an individual device to increase student participation and increase content understanding.

Each student will be **assigned** a chromebook for the school year. (it is not yours to keep):

A Chromebook and a charger



Student Expectations

Each Student will be responsible for the following:

You will be responsible for bringing the chromebook to school everyday, fully charged.



Chromebook Covers

Devine ISD will NOT provide covers, but it is highly recommended that one is purchased.



Insurance for your Chromebook

You may choose to purchase insurance for your chromebook for **\$20.00**. It is good for one school year and will help cover the cost of repair/damage that may occur to the chromebook.



Available Chromebook Insurance

- **With insurance**, the first repair is covered. For subsequent repairs, the student/parent is responsible for the full cost of the repair
- **Without insurance**, the student/parent is responsible for the full cost of the repair.

If your chromebook gets damaged:



Student must turn chromebook into the *Drop Zone* (in the library), and complete the repair form with Mrs. Wimett

Student may check out a loaner chromebook (if one is available)- this must be returned back to the *Drop Zone* before the end of the school day. (\$5.00/day fee if not returned)

Any charges due to repair or loss will be added to the student obligation lists and must be paid in full in order for student to participate in certain school activities and graduation.

If your chromebook becomes lost or stolen: (72 hour rule)

Lost - student must report the lost chromebook immediately to campus administration and will be responsible for paying for the replacement cost of the chromebook

Stolen - a police report must be filed within 72 hours and filed with campus administration. If the report is filed within 72 hours, the replacement fee may be waived. If no report is filed, it is considered a loss and the student is responsible for paying for the replacement cost of the chromebook.

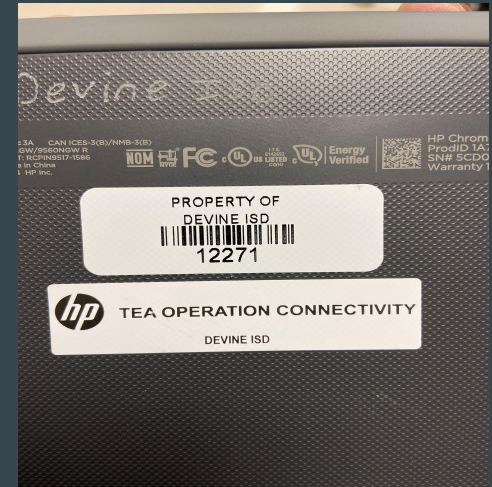

Receiving and Returning your Chromebook:

Each student at DHS will be assigned a chromebook during your english class on Tuesday, February 16th (students must have their student ID with them at this time) and must return the chromebook at the end of the school year or when the student withdraws during the school year.



Can students bring their own laptops?

DHS students can not bring their own laptop to school to use in the classroom. DHS internet is currently only available to the chromebooks, not personal technology.



DHS General Chromebook Rules:



- Chromebooks are school property and students must follow Student Acceptable Use Agreement
- Do not loan devices to other students
- Do not borrow a device from another student
- Do not share passwords or usernames
- No writing, stickers, drawings or labels allowed on the chromebooks
- No food or drink next to your Chromebook
- No sitting on or placing heavy objects on top of laptop
- Devine ISD inventory tag must be on at all times and not tampered with
- Chromebooks must NEVER be left in an unlocked locker, unlocked car or any unsupervised area



Photos, Games and APPs

- Make sure that all photos on your chromebook are worthy to show your parents.
- Inappropriate content will be NOT be allowed on chromebooks
- Apps rated 17+, Mature content, Explicit content, rated R Movies or TV-MA are not allowed on the chromebooks.
